**PRESS NOTE**

**Allotment of Professional/Technical/Non-Technical Courses reserved for Malayalee Origin for the academic session 2017-2018**

Applications are invited from the Malayalee Origin candidates settled in A & N Islands in the prescribed form for allotment of the following seats which are usually reserved for them every year by the Government of Kerala, for nomination during the current academic session 2017-18. Names of discipline and number of seats specified hereunder are provisional and are based on last year's allocation.

Sl. No.	Name of the course	No. of seats	Eligibility criteria
1.	M.B.B.S (Malayalee Origin)	01	Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognised equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology/Biotechnology separately, and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology/Biotechnology put together, are eligible. <b>Only those candidates who qualify in NEET-UG as per the Qualifying criteria described in the Information Bulletin of NEET-UG 2017 will be considered for admission to MBBS Course.</b>
2.	B.A.M.S (Malayalee Origin)	01	Candidates, who have passed pre-degree or any other examination recognized by the Universities in Kerala State as equivalent thereto with 50% marks in biology separately and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together, are eligible.
3.	B.Sc (Agri) (Malayalee Origin)	01	

The Malayalee Origin candidates, whose parent have settled in A & N Islands permanently can apply for the above seats, provided such candidates have a minimum of 10 years continuous education in these Islands. Applicants are required to submit the filled in application form alongwith self-attested copies of Xth and XIIth class Pass Certificates, Statement of marks, Birth Certificates, Migration Certificates, Duration Certificate and the certificate to the effect that he/she is of Malayalee Origin settled in these Islands, from the Revenue Authority not below the rank of Tehsildar, certificate of 10 years continuous education in these Islands from the Head of Institutions where the candidates studied for last 10 years and the local certificate from the Revenue Authority, and submit the same to the Development-IV Section (Higher Education), Secretariat, Port Blair by **28<sup>th</sup> June, 2017 upto 5.00 p.m.**

Nominations will be issued only after getting the confirmation from the concerned State Government about reservation of above seats during the current academic year 2017-18.

The Administration will not be responsible, in case any candidature is rejected by the State Institution/Colleges on account of change in eligibility criteria/ requirement or policy or late reporting to the Institutions.

For determination of merit, the practical marks will not be taken into account for the courses mentioned at Sl. No. 2 & 3. However, both the theory and practical marks will be shown in the nomination letter.
