Press Note

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission into five year integrated B.A., LL.B., Degree Course for the academic year 2017-18. The prospectus along with admission form can be obtained from the Office of the Principal, Andaman Law College, Phoenix Bay, Port Blair - 744101 between 10:00 AM and 03:30 PM w.e.f **14th June, 2017** in person on payment of Rs. 200/- in cash or Rs. 300/- in the form of a Demand Draft drawn in favour of the Principal by post. The name of the candidate should be written on the back of the demand draft.

The last date for submission filled in admission form is at 05:00 PM on **05th July, 2017**.

As per admission criteria students who have passed +2 from any stream are eligible. The minimum percentage of marks is not below 45% of the total marks in case of General Category applicants and 40% of the total marks in case of OBC and ST applicants. Candidates with compartment/supplementary in any subject in the qualifying examination will not be eligible for admission. Candidates who have obtained (10+2) through Open University systems directly without any basic qualification (passing X Standard in regular stream) are not eligible for admission.

Applicant of general category should not be more than 20 years of age and for ST/OBC not more than 22 years as on 01st July, 2017. Consequent on passing interim order by the Supreme Court staying the age limit for law admission prescribed by BCI, others may also apply. However their admission will be subject to the outcome of the final order to be passed by the Supreme Court.

The intake of students for admission is limited to 30 and will be allotted to various categories as per Govt. of India norms Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi's Order No. U-14040/5/96/ANL, dated 30th May 1996.

20 % for tribal; 10% for Children of Deputationist and Central Govt. employees; 50% for Pre-42 and Settlers; 20% for who do not fall under any of the above categories but had 10 years continuous education in these islands. One seat will be reserved for differently abled person. The unutilised seats of the above categories will be given on general merit open to all the residents of this island. These details are available in the prospectus and on the notice board of the Andaman Law College.
