7	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruitment	<u>Essential:</u> 1. Diploma in Naturopathy/Yoga of minimum 04 (Four) years duration awarded by recognized Board/ University. 2. Class 'B' registration in Naturopathy & Yoga from any State/ Board/IMC 3. 02 (Two) years' experience in Yoga from any recognized/reputed Organization /Institution or Department. Proficiency in English/Hindi. <u>Note-1:</u> Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in case of candidates otherwise well qualified. <u>Note-2:</u> The qualification regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall be ‘Not exceeding 56 years’ as on the closing date of receipt of applications)”. <u>Note:</u> for the purpose of appointment of deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 01-01-2016/the date from which the revised pay structure bases on 7 th Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding Pay Matrix extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one level of Pay matrix and where this benefit will extend only for the posts(s) for which that level of Pay Matrix is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
