DRAFT NOTIFICATION

No. -----F. No. 6-1(9)/2023-MPH(Mazdoor/Field Worker)-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. 14-3/60-ANL dated 11th April, 1960 and in partial modification of Administration's Notification No.184 dated 14/07/2010 and Notification No.68 dated 09/06/2021, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby proposes to make the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of "**Mazdoor/Field Worker**", Group 'C' (Non-Gazetted/ Non Ministerial) in the establishment of Directorate of Health Services under Andaman & Nicobar Administration.

Objections and suggestions are invited from the stake holders/persons to be affected thereby. The objections and suggestions (if any) should reach the Office of Director of Health Services, A & N Administration within 30 days from the date of publication for consideration.

1. Short Title and Commencement:-

- i. These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration Group-'C' (Non-Gazetted/Non Ministerial) Posts of **Mazdoor/Field Worker** in the Directorate of Health Services Recruitment Rules, 2023.
- ii. These shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay:-

The number of Posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in Para 2 to 4 of the Schedules annexed thereto.

3. Method of Recruitment, Age Limit and Other Qualification:-

The method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Para 5 to 13 of the attached schedule.

4. Initial Constitution of the service:-

The **Mazdoor/Field Worker** working on regular basis under the Health Department of this Administration as on the date of publication of this rules in the Official Gazette, their services shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules and they shall be members of the service.

5. Disqualification:-

No person-

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living.

OR

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administration), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the provision of these Rules.

6. Powers to Relax:-

Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, if necessary, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving:-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

ANNEXURE TO SCHEDULE-IV
DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE POST OF 'MAZDOOR/FIELD WORKER

1. He is responsible for day-today NVBDC works under direct supervision of Head Worker/Surveillance Worker, Malaria Inspector.
2. He will help the Head Worker/Surveillance Worker in collecting material and equipment required for the day's work.
3. He will check the equipment whether in good working condition and leak proof.
4. He will apply the recommended larvicide in all the breeding places assigned to him with correct dosage and technique.
5. He will be held responsible, if any breeding place is left untreated in his area.
6. He will keep the drains and water collections free of vegetation.
7. He will ensure that water storage containers are emptied once in a week.
8. He will obey the instructions of Head Worker/Surveillance Worker for all sorts of duties connected with anti-larval measures such as source reduction, minor engineering, desilting, etc. assigned to him.
